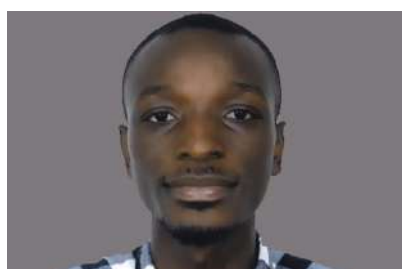

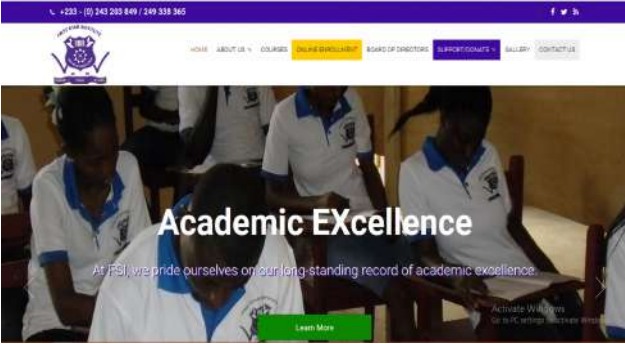

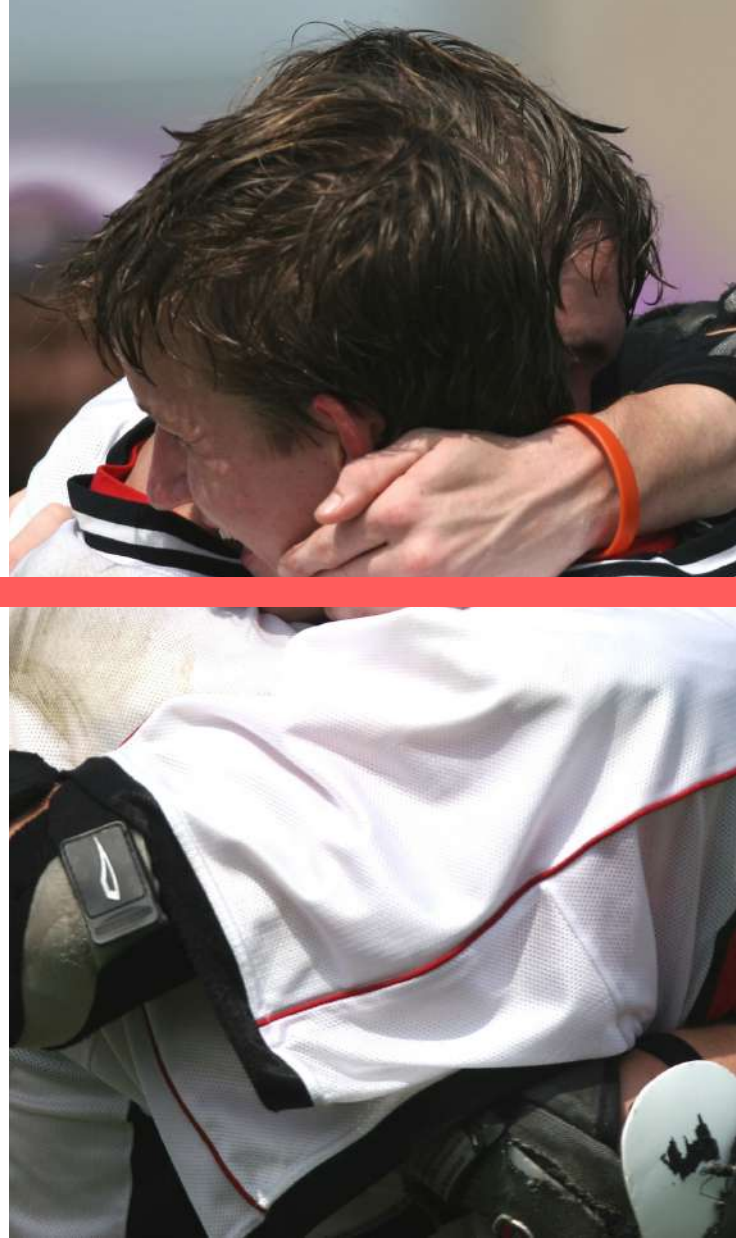
GET INVOLVED TODAY
